

How Does DAN Help Divers?



Step 1

If an Accident Occurs or Symptoms Appear a DAN Member calls a DAN Supported Emergency Hotline

Members receive a Membership Card with the Emergency Hotline Numbers. Members who need help call a DAN Hotline and are connected to a highly experienced doctor or medic. A phone evaluation determines the necessary action.

DAN helps thousands of divers every year, all over the world, with these Hotlines.

Step 2

DAN Activates a Plan of Action

DAN contacts international and local service providers for transport and/or treatment if required. These networks have been established over the 30+ years of DAN's existence.

Action depends on the divers symptoms, location and necessary treatment.

Step 3

DAN Liaises with Treating Doctors

DAN is constantly in contact with the diver and the doctors & service providers involved in the evacuation and treatment of the Member.

Step 4

DAN Arranges Payment for Treatment / Transport

Diving Emergencies can be expensive. An evacuation can cost as much as US\$100,000 and Treatment can cost many thousands of dollars.

DAN coverage is great value, providing 12-months coverage and invaluable peace-of-mind.

Step 5

DAN Provides Follow-up

DAN experts review the situation and advise if any further action or treatment is required.

At all times DAN is available to the Member under treatment.
